COMMUNITY MOSQUITO CONTROL

While mosquitoes are certainly a nuisance for outdoor enthusiasts, more worrisome are the health risks and health care costs associated with the spread of West Nile virus (WNV) and other diseases that may be carried by mosquitoes.
